- Preferably a Digital Desk DIGIDESIGN PROFILE or SC 48.
- Our engineer must have access to all outboard processing/PA processing at FOH.
- FOH Desk MUST be directly in the center, 2/3 the length of the venue in front of the PA. The Stage/FOH power source must be earthed and on a separate generator from the Lighting source
- We require 6 LOUD stage Monitors. Each Aux send must have a 31 band Graphic EQ Inserted if the FOH board is Analogue.
- We require 2 IEMS with Ear pieces.

Tall Boom Stands – 11

Small Stands - 4

DI Boxes - Radial/BSS only

- 1. **SOUNDCHECK** PRCHASER shall not allow audience to enter place of performance until technical set-up has been completed. ARTIST requires a minimum Two (2) hour sound check <u>after</u> completion of load-in and setup. Purchasers are required to comply with this policy unless otherwise agreed in writing with the artist's representative.
- 2. STAGE HANDS PURCHASER shall provide a minimum of three (3) stage- hands to help ARTIST's crew for load-in, stage set-up and load-out. In cases where ARTIST is staying overnight in the town of performance, PURCHASER will store ARTIST'S equipment overnight in a secured area and make it available to ARTIST the following day upon departure..
- 3. **RECORDING -** No other copies of either the audio or video recordings are permitted without advance written permission from Artist Representatives
- 4. **STAGE -** The stage should be a minimum of 32' wide x 18' deep. The stage must be accessible in a manner other than through the audience. PURCHASER shall provide:
 - (a) KEYBOARD STANDS for LAPTOP/FLUTES and DULCIMER. (3 nos)
 - (b) RISER with MAT (for Drums, Tabla and Keys)— Minimum 12' Wide x 8' Deep x 2' High. Must be carpeted.

- 6. **SOUND REQUIREMENTS:** SEE ATTACHED SOUND SPECIFICATION AND INPUT LIST
- 7. HOSPITALITY: no special requirments besides the choice of both veg and non veg food and perhaps some beer and wine.
